

Update on Your Application: North St. Louis Small Business & Non-Profit Grant Program

Dear Grant Applicant,

You are one of 227 businesses receiving this email because you applied for the North St. Louis Small Business & Non-Profit Grant Program prior to August 1, 2023, when the revised application was launched. The SLDC team has been working hard to ensure the more than 700 applications received are complete and eligible to move forward for further evaluation and possible funding for completing the capacity building opportunities outlined below. Thank you for your patience during this process.

On February 15, SLDC's Board of Directors approved a resolution to award grants to eligible businesses and non-profits that have completed capacity building activities offered through the program. **All geographically eligible applicants who submitted a complete application on time are eligible for the capacity building grants. SLDC is offering \$2,500 for each business or non-profit that completes the Technical Assistance Academy and \$2,500 for completing their business financial assessment, for a total of \$5,000. At this time, approximately 150 applicants qualify and have completed one or both of these opportunities. Those applicants will be contacted with the next steps to receive funding within the next five business days.** We anticipate funding close to 600 applicants with these Capacity Building Grants.

Before we can move forward with grant agreements for the Capacity Building Grants, eligibility criteria must be confirmed for each applicant, including:

- Business or non-profit **operating** address is within the geographic boundaries (Unfortunately, some businesses geographically eligible under the original legislation (Board Bill 82) [Ordinance 71504](#), are not eligible under the revised legislation (Board Bill 37) [Ordinance 71696](#), which redefined the geographic eligibility boundaries.)
- [Verify Geographic Eligibility](#)
- Application submitted via email, USPS mail (postmark) or hand delivered to SLDC **on or before 11:59 p.m. on August 1, 2023**
- Business and/or owner has submitted only one application for funding
- Business owner has control of redevelopment or development site, if applicable

If your application does not meet the criteria above, you will receive notification within the next five business days.

If your application meets the above criteria, you should have already been contacted by a [Grow America](#) (formerly NDC) representative and been asked to participate in a viability assessment and two capacity building opportunities:

- Financial assessment (process to understand the impact of COVID-19 to your business) – Opportunity to receive \$2,500 upon completion
- Technical Assistance Academy (training programs to provide capacity and support for your ability to operate a viable business into the future) – Opportunity to receive \$2,500 upon completion

Congratulations to the over 150 entities who have completed one or both of the capacity building opportunities offered. These applicants will be contacted within five business days to receive next step requirements for funding.

Funding Requirement

SLDC must run a current CBI check on ALL applicants prior to disbursing funds to ensure you are in good standing with the City of St. Louis [Collector of Revenue](#) and the [Business License Office](#). Current CBI clearance (received within 30 days of deposit) is required to receive any funds from this program.

Although you may have submitted your CBI clearance with your application, your CBI clearance may now be outdated. So please make sure your business license, taxes, water-refuse bills and earnings/payroll taxes are up-to-date to avoid any delays in funding opportunities.
